Our Heritage Ranch will provide homemade lasagna and enchilada dinners (one per evening) with salad and sides for \$8.00 ea.

There is a grill on the property if you want to bring your own steak and we'll be working out of the kitchen in the B&B house if you need kitchen facilities.

High Plains Homestead has restaurant and bar and Friday and Saturday nights are exclusively "Cookout" nights featuring rib-eye steaks(\$17.95), BBQ pork ribs (\$16.95) and Salmon (\$16.95). Each includes salad, baked beans, potatoes. Pie is available for dessert at an additional cost.
